## **His First Major Vote Was For “The Hollywood Handout”**

Dear Fellow Republican,

Jason Patchett was appointed to our Assembly District 19 seat in the Nevada Assembly last November by the Democrats on the Clark County Commission.

He'd been in office less than five days when he cast the most important vote of that entire special legislative session.

**And he got it completely wrong!**

He Voted for the \$1.8 Billion “Hollywood Handout.”

Assembly Bill 5 would have been the single largest corporate subsidy in Nevada history.

\$120 million a year. Every year. For fifteen years. All of it flowing to billion-dollar “woke” entertainment giants Sony Pictures and Warner Bros. Discovery.

Nevada's own nonpartisan budget analysts delivered a brutal verdict: Nevada would get back just 23 cents for every dollar given away.

The bill would blow a \$62 million structural hole in the state budget by 2030 - forcing future lawmakers to do one of two things: Raise your taxes. Or cut your services.

There is no third option. There never is. Patchett knew all of this. He voted yes anyway.

### **Look at What's Happening in California Right Now.**

You want to know where this road leads? Look west.

Los Angeles is already spending \$750 million a year on film tax credits - and Hollywood is still fleeing.

So what are California's politicians doing? Demanding more.

LA Mayor Karen Bass just called for eliminating the cap entirely. Her rival Nithya Raman is doing the same. No cap. No ceiling. No limit.

And it still isn't enough. Because once government starts down this road - it never stops. It only gets bigger. You and I know this. It isn't even arguable.

Every state that plays this game learns the same lesson: there is no finish line.

Only bigger handouts. Only more of your money going to corporations already worth tens of billions of dollars.

### **This Is Not What Republicans Stand For.**

Patchett has defended his vote by saying cutting taxes on corporations is "a very Republican thing to do."

He's missing the point - deliberately or otherwise.

AB5 didn't cut taxes for Nevada businesses. It created special transferable credits that Sony and Warner Bros. could sell to other corporations for immediate cash.

The studios pocket the money. Nevada taxpayers cover the difference. Over 98 percent of Nevada's existing film credits have been transferred this way.

That's not tax relief. That's a wealth transfer from your family to a Hollywood boardroom. And Republicans shouldn't be voting for it.

Even a Democrat from Reno - Assemblywoman Selena La Rue Hatch - had the backbone to say what our Republican assemblyman wouldn't:

"If we pass this bill, we are either going to have to raise taxes or we are going to have to cut services. And I cannot stand and watch our children suffer as we cut our school budget."

A Democrat said it. Jason Patchett didn't.

### **He Was Appointed - Now He Wants to Be Elected.**

Patchett was handed this seat days before the Hollywood Handout vote. He had never served a single day in the Legislature. And it showed.

But now he's asking AD19 Republicans to make it permanent - while claiming his top priority is "protecting the taxpayer."

The Hollywood Handout was stopped by the State Senate - barely, by one vote.

But the lobbyists will be back in 2027 with the same bill, the same promises, and a fresh round of campaign contributions.

When that day comes, AD19 needs a representative who reads the numbers, ignores the lobbyists, and votes "NO!"

Jason Patchett already showed you he won't. I will.

My name is Amy Groves. I'm running because you deserve a conservative representative who puts taxpayers first.

Not Hollywood studios, not billion-dollar corporations, and not the lobbyists who fly into Carson City with other people's money.

Real tax relief for everyone. A budget that doesn't blow up on purpose. Schools that are funded. Streets that are safe.
